What is an art evaluation?

Due to the variations and individuality of each piece of artwork, our conservator begins with an in-depth evaluation of the item to ascertain the level and type of any damage or deterioration, the materials used in its creation, any varnish/finishes present and the type, the stability of the substrate and/or structure, condition of the frame, and any previous repairs in order to provide a comprehensive and accurate proposal to meet the needs of the piece as well as our client's goals.

How long does it take?

Because we serve clients all over the U.S., the demand for our restoration services is high. Evaluations can take 4-6 weeks and the restoration work itself can take 12 weeks or more depending on the complexity of the work.

What type of artwork do you restore?

Our team is able to restore many different types of artwork. Paintings on canvas, panel, and other substrates, as well as sculptures, ceramics and so much more.

Is there a cost?

Due to the technical and in depth nature of the evaluation there is a \$250.00 (plus tax) non-refundable fee. Should you decide to move forward with any of the proposed work, 50% of that fee will be credited towards your total cost.

What do I do now?

The artwork can be dropped off at our office or we can schedule a time for pick up by our Logistics Team. Pick up & delivery is offered for \$195.00 each way in the RDU area. This is when the evaluation fee will be collected.

Wait for your evaluation report and then decide if you would like to move forward with restoration. Should you

move forward we will credit half of the evaluation fee to your total and collect a 50% deposit

When the work has been completed we will reach out to you and arrange a
