

Radio Evaluations

What is a radio evaluation?

Due to the technical nature of radios and the expertise needed in their restoration, our team starts with an evaluation that includes examination of every component. This allows our team to determine what needs to be replaced, repaired, or rebuilt. This includes internal wiring, tubes, speakers, record players, and any other component that is part of your radio. A full report is then created that details its restoration and associated costs.

How long does it take?

Evaluations can take 6-8 weeks and the restoration can take 6-12 months from the time you approve the work. If you decide not to move forward, our specialist will need 6-8 weeks to reassemble the unit and have it ready for pick up. Because we serve clients all over the U.S., the demand for our restoration services is high. Thus, we have an evaluation queue that we add our clients to. If you'd like to have your radio evaluated, we'll add you to our queue and call you when we're ready to receive the next queue of radios for evaluation.

Is there a cost?

Due to the technical and in depth nature of the evaluation there is a \$350.00 (plus tax) non-refundable fee. Should you decide to move forward with any of the proposed work, 50% of that fee will be credited towards your total cost. Generally we find that technical restoration falls in the range of \$2500-\$5000.

What do I do now?

Before



- Let us know you would like to be on the queue for evaluation. We will need your name, phone number and email address.
- We will reach out when our team is ready to receive more radios.

Depending on your location, the radio can be dropped off at our office, shipped to us, or picked up by our Logistics Team. Pick up & delivery is offered for \$200.00. This is when the evaluation fee will be collected.

After



- Wait for your evaluation report and then decide if you would like to move forward with restoration. Should you move forward we will credit half of the evaluation fee to your total and collect a 50% deposit. If you decide not to move forward, our specialist will need 6-8 weeks to reassemble the unit and have it ready for pick up.

When the work has been completed we will reach out to you and arrange a time for pick up, shipment back to you, or delivery by our Logistics Team. The remainder of the balance will then be collected.
